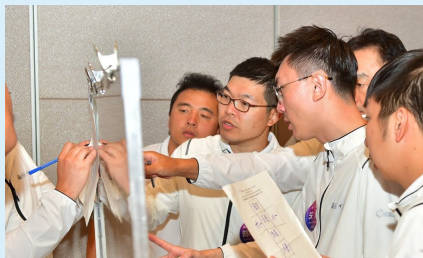

CKGSB is the first business school in China to design and deliver programs for unicorn and soon-to-be-unicorn companies since 2015.

We have been working with industry leaders, like **Alibaba, Amazon, Baidu, ByteDance, JD.com, SenseTime, Tencent, Microsoft (China)**, and leading venture capitals, to offer founders of companies with at least Series A funding the knowledge, network and financing that they need to scale up.

Our China programs are increasingly focused on helping unicorns explore **deep tech**, including the smart cars, semiconductors, industrial Internet, new materials, robotics, biomedicine, 5G, VR/AR and aerospace technology.

1,188 CKGSB alumni with at least Series A funding | **90%** company founders or co-founders | **77%** Gained series A financing upon joining the program



Starting in 2016, we began extending our successful experience in China to Europe, delivering **11 programs** that have helped more than **200 European entrepreneurs** across **30 industries** and **37 countries** to develop into potential unicorns. Among the participating **159** companies, **49%** have secured Pre-A and A+ rounds of funding, and **three** have become unicorn companies (Unbabel, Portugal; Sword Health, Portugal; and Teladoc Health, USA) since our program.

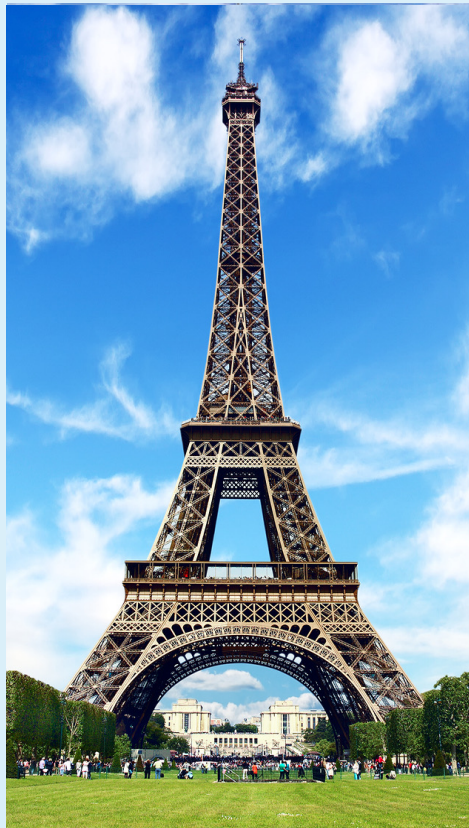

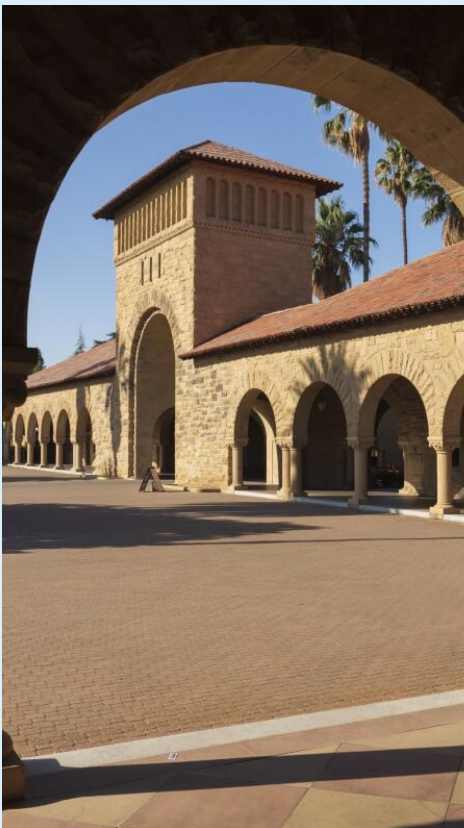
